

McMurray Middle School Athlete Compliance Form

An athlete must READ and agree to follow the Activities Code for Vashon Island School District #402. By signing this form the athlete agrees to follow the Activities Code for McMurray Middle School

- In order to participate on an athletic team at McMurray, a student must read and sign this form.
- An athlete must agree to follow practice turn-out rules specified by his/her coach.

Attendance at school: Student participants shall be expected to attend and participate in all classes for the entire school day in order to participate in practice or competition. The only exceptions are medical excuses signed by a doctor and approved school related activities.

1. A student who arrives to class AFTER first period is considered absent and is not eligible to participate in that day's athletic event, nor may he/she travel with the team.
2. A student who does not attend a class during the school day or leaves class early without authorization from his/her teacher and signing out at the office is absent from class and will not be eligible to participate in that day's athletic event, nor may he/she travel with the team.
3. If a student participates in a game/match and the administration later discovers that the student was out of compliance to the attendance rule, that athlete will not play in the next game/match nor travel with the team.

Eligibility is based upon the following criteria:

Athletes must maintain a 2.0 or better grade point average and no F grades. Two eligibility checks will be held during each sport season.

- *Fall (football, volleyball & boys soccer) prior year ending grades & Oct. 6*
- *Late fall (boys basketball & girls soccer) 1st 6-week progress & Jan. 5*
- *Winter (girls basketball & wrestling) 2nd 6-week progress & March 16*
- *Spring (track) 4th 6-week progress & May 4*

If you have negative checks regarding academics or behavior you will be ineligible for the next competition, but you must attend practices. Your parents will be notified if you are ineligible.

If an athlete is deemed ineligible he/she must do weekly checks in order to regain eligibility.

If an athlete is assigned to after school detention he/she must serve the detention on the day assigned regardless of practice schedule. The student may attend practice after the detention is served.

If an athlete falls below a C grade the principal will be notified and an improvement plan developed.
