- 1. The student and parent must READ and agree to follow the Activities Code for Vashon Island School District #402. **The student agrees to follow the Activities Code for Vashon Island High School by signing this form.**
- 2. The student and parent must READ and sign this form in order to participate on a team/activity at Vashon Island High School.
- 3. The student must present a Release to Participate Form (Green Card) to his/her coach/advisor before participating.
- 4. A student must agree to follow practice turnout rules specified by the coach/advisor.

The following is clarification of school attendance rules:

**Attendance at School:** Activities Code for Vashon Island School District #402, section IV, item B. Student participants shall be expected to attend and participate in all classes for the entire school day in order to participate in practice or competition.

*Clarification:* A student who is more than 20 minutes late to first period, does not attend a class during the school day, is more than 10 minutes late to class, or leaves a class early without authorization from his/her teacher and without signing out at the office will be considered absent and will not be eligible to participate in that day's event.

**Academic Eligibility, (refer to Section VI of the Activities Code for full details):**

*Final Grades:* Eligibility for a sport/activity is based on the previous trimester final grades. (The GPA for incoming freshmen will be based on the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of eighth grade.) If a student has a GPA below 2.0 or any incomplete grades, the student is not eligible to compete for 10 school days. Students on academic suspension will begin progress reports on the last day of the suspension and will continue progress reports until midterm.

*Midterm Grades:* If a student has below a 2.0 GPA or any incompletes, the athlete is not eligible to compete until they have at least a 2.0 GPA. Progress reports will commence the Friday after midterms are posted and will continue until the end of the sports season.

**Appeal:**

If there is a violation of the Activities Code of Conduct and/or VHS school rules, the student may receive discipline that effects his/her eligibility. The student and his/her parent/guardian may appeal such disciplinary action per the VISD Student Responsibilities, Rights, and Due Process pamphlet.
